

- ➤ Entry Requirements: Employer driven. Typically, an apprentice might be expected to have achieved appropriate level 3 qualications on entry e.g. 3 GCE "A" Levels at Grades A to C, or a vocational equivalent. Apprentices are also expected to have typically achieved Maths and English at Level 2 prior to starting the apprenticeship.
